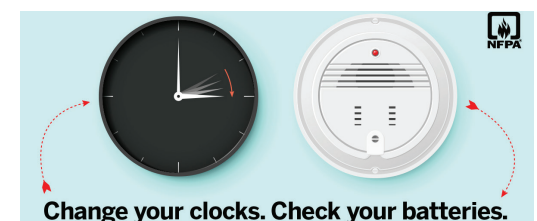

## Shut-off valve available

Sioux Center Municipal Utilities natural gas customers may request that the utilities install an excess flow valve (EFV) on the gas service to their property.

EFV's are mechanical shut-off devices installed in the pipe, designed to stop the flow of gas from the main to the inlet side of the meter. An EFV reduces risk of natural gas fire, explosion, injury, and/or property damage.

EFV's have been installed on new service lines in Sioux Center since 2009. Install costs are customer's responsibility. Call us at (712) 722-0761 to learn more.

An EFV does not control flow from the outlet side of the meter into the home in the event of damage to the customer side of the meter. Flow from the meter is controlled by the regulator adjacent to the meter.
