Softer water = haul less salt

Sioux Center water is now at about 25 grains of hardness with water blended from the Lewis & Clark Regional Water System.

The Sioux Center Water Department recommends customers adjust their water softeners down to 25 grains of hardness. When you do, you can save on salt and water used by the softener, as well as on wear and tear.

Consult with your softener supplier, a local plumber or the softener's manual.
