Check Your Pump

Make sure your sump pump drains to the storm sewer or your yard. Pumps may NOT discharge into the sanitary sewer system. They may pump on streets, but if the water starts to cause issues such as standing water, moss growth or ice build up, owner will need to find an alternative.

Beat the peaks: Cool down summer energy bills

Our community's peak electric demand occurs when temps are in the mid-90's and above, usually between 3-7 p.m.

If you reduce electric use in these periods, our overall customer peak demand is lower, helping delay

construction of new energy plants, which would increase rates. Charge your electric vehicle or phone over night and set your thermostat a little warmer from 3-7 p.m.

Highway 75 update

Crews are finishing utility installation from 2nd St. N (Fruited Plain) to 2nd St. S (Children's Dental), then will rebuild the Highway 75 roadbed there to prepare it for paving, possibly in July. Next, crews will do underground utility work between 2nd St S. and 5th St. S. This multi-year project is rebuilding Highway 75 focused on safety, function & Sioux Center's character.

Fireworks use in Sioux Center

Firework use is allowed in Sioux Center June 13-July 8 between 9 a.m.-10 p.m., with extended use to 11 p.m. on July 4 and the Saturdays/Sundays before and after July 4 (up to July 8). Must be 18 to use. A \$250 fine applies for misuse. Please pick up garbage after using fireworks and be respectful to neighbors.

Turn down your water softener

Sioux Center water users can dial back their water softeners with the addition of water from the Lewis & Clark Regional Water System.

Customers can adjust their water softeners down to 25 grains of hardness.

To adjust a softener, consult with your softener supplier, a local plumber or the softener's manual/online information.


