Sump pump notice

Sump pumps must drain into the storm sewer or your yard. They may NOT discharge into the sanitary sewer system (your drains).

Trees near streets

Trees cannot be planted in street right of way unless certain conditions are met. Interested in planting in right of way? Contact Kris at the City Office (712) 722-0761. Owner is responsible to maintain and trim trees in the road right of way.

Parking reminder

Parking is not allowed on grass on residential-zoned property. Vehicles must be parked on pavement, rock, or asphalt.

Warning sirens

The tornado sirens are designed to alert people outdoors. Do not rely on these inside your home.

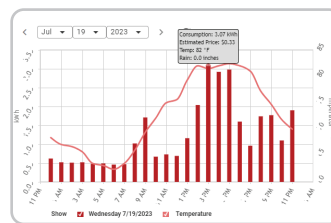
See your hourly utility use

See how you use utilities each hour with Sioux Center Municipal Utilities' online portal or in our app.

You can view hourly, daily, and monthly consumption (or use) for electricity, natural gas, and water and estimated cost for that period.

In the online portal, you can set up **water leak alerts** by text, email or phone call!

To see your use, log in to your online account at **www.sioxcenter.com/account** or click "Pay a Bill" on the City



website. If you don't have an online account yet, you can create one on that website.

Water rate change beginning

To continue to provide for customers' water needs in Sioux Center, a water rate change is starting with water used this month. A home using 5,000 gallons a month

will see about a \$10 increase in their bill. This will help build a new water tower, replace old pipes, and continue long-term reliable water service for all in Sioux Center.

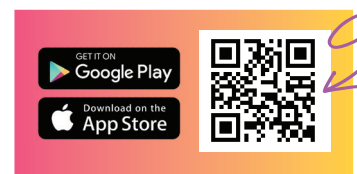

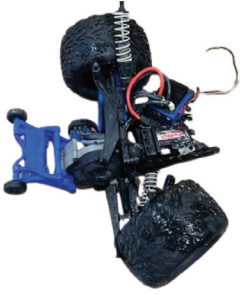


Back-to-school sales tax holiday
