## Check your furnace to get ready for winter

The Sioux Center Municipal Utilities Natural Gas Department is reminding you to test your furnace to make sure it is working well. If there are issues, call your plumber to address them before winter.

Have your furnace serviced regularly to ensure it is running efficiently.

Aging furnaces run the risk of having burners plugged, which can result in an incomplete burn of natural gas and emission of carbon dioxide.

**Make sure you have a carbon monoxide detector** and check that it is working properly.
