Highway 75 construction begins this month

The first phase of rebuilding Highway 75 begins in April. Construction will begin on the west side of the highway between 20th St. S and 13th St. S. Traffic will shift to the east side.

Mid summer, work on 16th St. S will begin.

In the fall, highway construction will switch

to the east side, and traffic will shift to the new pavement on the west. Construction of medians and landscaping will be in 2024. Regular work schedule will be Monday-Friday, 7 a.m.-7 p.m.

Easter Egg Hunt on April 8

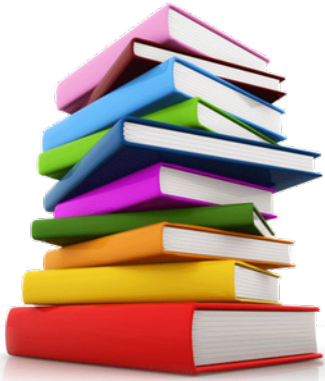
